Update of the Elmore County Comprehensive Plan

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to the Ordinances of Elmore County and the Laws of the State of Idaho, that the Elmore County Planning and Zoning Commission will hold a public meeting in the South Fork Boise Senior Center, 350 N. Pine-Featherville Road, Pine, Idaho, at 2:00 p.m., on WEDNESDAY, July 31, 2013. The purpose of the meeting is to receive input on an update to the Comprehensive Plan for the unincorporated areas of Pine, Featherville, Rocky Bar, and Atlanta in Elmore County. This Comprehensive Plan will affect future land use in the unincorporated areas in Elmore County.

The current Comprehensive Plan may be reviewed prior to the meeting in the Land Use and Building Department during regular business hours. It is also available for viewing at the Elmore County webpage, <http://www.elmorecounty.org>. Any and all interested persons can provide input at said public meeting and the public is welcome and invited to submit information. Anyone who wishes to testify, but is unable to attend may submit written documentation prior to the meeting by sending it to Elmore County Land Use and Building Department, 520 East 2<sup>nd</sup> South Street, Mountain Home, Idaho, 83647. Written testimony must be received by 5:00 pm on July 22, 2013.
