NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho and Ordinances of Elmore County, that the Elmore County Planning and Zoning Commission will hold a PUBLIC HEARING at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 7, 2018 in the War Memorial Hall (American Legion) 515 East 2nd South Street, Mountain Home, Idaho, to accept testimony and consider Revocation of a Conditional Use Permit for a 2-lot subdivision in a Agriculture (Ag) Zone granted in 2014. Case Number: CUP-2014-06. The site is located in Section 34, Township 3 South, Range 6 East, B.M. A common mean of locating the property is from I-84 take exit 95 toward Mountain Home, turn south on American Legion Blvd. Turn left onto N. Main Street, continue to ID 51 S turn left onto ID 51S for approximately for 11/2 miles, turn right onto SW Smith for approximately 0.6 miles. The property is located on the right side of the road at 2848 SW Smith.
