Within the 1994/1995 general session of the Idaho State Legislature, the Idaho Local Planning Act was amended to include private property rights as a required Comprehensive Planning Component and there is a need to update the Elmore County Comprehensive Plan in order to meet Idaho State Law, plus new changes to facilitate economic develop in the county. The amendments provide that land use policies, restrictions, conditions, and fees do not violate private property rights, adversely impact property values, or create unnecessary technical limitation on the use of property; and provide additional policy to allow for siting of manufactured homes.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication according to law.
