ORDINANCE NO. 96-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ELMORE, STATE OF IDAHO, AMENDING PREVIOUS ELMORE COUNTY ORDINANCE 83-3, SECTION 1, PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF FEES IN THE AMOUNT OF THE ACTUAL COSTS INCURRED BY ELMORE COUNTY FOR REQUIRED SURVEYING OR ENGINEERING SERVICES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Elmore County, Idaho, as follows:

That Elmore County Ordinance 83-3, Section 1, be and the same is amended to provide as follows:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners of Elmore County, Idaho, pursuant to Idaho Code Section 50-1305 and other applicable statutes, desires to provide for the collection of reasonable fees from subdividers of real property for the services of a qualified surveyor or engineer, chosen and required by the County of Elmore to check, survey, analyze and certify proposed plats and computations thereon; to determine whether the legal requirements for approval of said plats have been met, and to certify compliance of said plat. Such fees shall be determined or computed by the actual cost or costs incurred by the County of Elmore for the required surveying or engineering services.


PASSED AND APPROVED by a unanimous vote of the members of the full Board of Commissioners at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Elmore County, State of Idaho, on the 29th day of May, 1996, and duly enacted as an ordinance of Elmore County, State of Idaho.
