

ORDINANCE FOR A CONTRACT WITH PUBLIC HEALTH DISTRICT IV AUGMENTATION OF ON-SITE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SERVICES AND LAND DEVELOPMENT SERVICES, CONTRACT FOR SERVICES WITH CENTRAL DISTRICT HEALTH DEPARTMENT FEE SCHEDULE AND ALTERATION BY DOUBLE RESOLUTION; CRIMINAL PENALTY FOR FAILURE TO OBTAIN PERMIT; REPLACING ELMORE COUNTY ORDINANCE 3; EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the installation of sewage disposal systems could impact the public health, and

WHEREAS, the present funding of the sewage disposal and land development programs does not cover the cost of the program to Public Health District IV, and

WHEREAS, the services provided by Public Health District IV are important to protect the public health;

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED, by the Board of Commissioners of Elmore County, Idaho that the following ordinance be adopted:

Section 1. No building permit shall be issued in Elmore County without authorization or a permit from Central District Health Department (Health District IV).

Section 2. Elmore County hereby establishes fees to augment the funding of the sewage disposal and land development programs for Public Health District IV. These fees will include those currently authorized for collection by the Idaho State Board of Health.

Section 3. The fee schedule will be as follows:

Subsurface Sewage Permit Application	\$221.00	
Community On-Site Subsurface Sewage Permit	\$221.00	+\$10/dwelling for each 250 gal. of flow
Renewal of Existing Subsurface Permit	\$ 34.00	
Sanitary Restriction Release Application for Subdivision Plats served by a Public System (sewage).	\$ 50.00	
Sanitary Restriction Release Application for Subdivision Plats served by on-site sewage disposal.	\$106.00	per lot
Parcel Review Fee	\$ 93.00	

These fees may be altered by resolution.

Section 4. That it shall be unlawful for any owner of property, other person to install or have installed any sewage disposal system without first obtaining a permit.

It shall be unlawful and punishable as a misdemeanor by a fine of not to exceed THREE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$300) DOLLARS, or by imprisonment in the County Jail for a term of not to exceed six months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 5. In addition to any criminal penalty, Public Health District IV may impose a double fee against any person who is in violation of this ordinance.

Section 6. This ordinance shall repeal Elmore County Ordinance No. 94-3 in its entirety.

THIS ORDINANCE shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication on June 12, 1996.

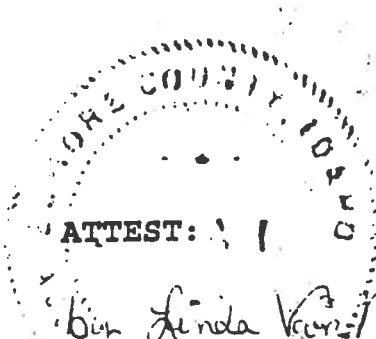



ELMORE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 343

ORDINANCE FOR A CONTRACT WITH PUBLIC HEALTH DISTRICT IV FOR AUGMENTATION OF ON-SITE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SERVICES AND LAND DEVELOPMENT SERVICES, CONTRACT FOR SERVICES WITH CENTRAL DISTRICT HEALTH DEPARTMENT, SEE SCHEDULE AND ALTERATION BY DOUBLE RESOLUTION, CRIMINAL PENALTIES, PENALTY FOR FAILURE TO OBTAIN PERMIT, REPLACING ELMORE COUNTY ORDINANCE 343, EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS the installation of sewage disposal systems could impact the public health and safety of the community and

WHEREAS the present funding of the sewage disposal and land development programs does not cover the cost of the program to Public Health District IV and

WHEREAS the services provided by Public Health District IV are important to the public health and safety of the community and

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED, by the Board of Commissioners of Elmore County, Idaho, that the following ordinance be adopted:

Section 1. No building permit shall be issued in Elmore County without authorization of a permit from Central District Health Department (Health District IV).

Section 2. Elmore County hereby establishes fees to augment the funding of the sewage disposal and land development programs for Public Health District IV. These fees will include those currently authorized for collection by the Idaho State Board of Health.

Section 3. The fee schedule will be as follows:
Subsurface Sewage Permit Application \$21.00
Community On-Site Subsurface Sewage Permit \$10/dwelling for 250 gal. of flow
Renewal of Existing Subsurface Permit \$10
Primary Restriction Release Application for Subdivision Plats served by a Public System (sewage) \$60.00
Primary Restriction Release Application for Subdivision Plats served by on-site sewage disposal \$108.00 per lot
Parcel Review Fee \$93.00

Section 4. These fees may be altered by resolution.

Section 5. That it shall be unlawful for any owner of property or other person to install or have installed any sewage disposal system without first obtaining a permit.

Section 6. It shall be unlawful and punishable as a misdemeanor by a fine not to exceed THREE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$300) DOLLARS, or by imprisonment in the County Jail for a term of not to exceed six months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 7. In addition to any criminal penalty, Public Health District IV may impose a double fee against any person who is in violation of this ordinance.

Section 8. This ordinance shall repeal Elmore County Ordinance No. 343 in its entirety.

THIS ORDINANCE shall be in full force and effect after its adoption, approval and publication on June 12, 1996.
