NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho and Ordinances of Elmore County, that the Elmore County Planning and Zoning Commission will hold a PUBLIC HEARING at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 19, 2019, in the War Memorial Hall (American Legion) 515 East 2nd South Street, Mountain Home, Idaho, to accept testimony and consider an application from Jaren Sayer for a Conditional Use Permit to conduct a Chiropractic Business at his property in Featherville, Idaho; the property is zoned Agriculture. Case Number: CUP-2019-03. The site is located at Section 09, SE ¼ T3N R10E, B.M. A common way of locating the property is to head east on American Legion Blvd, continue on Highway 20 East for 31.5 miles, turn left on Forest 61 for 17.5 miles, turn slight right onto Forest Road 114 for 4.8 miles then turn right onto North Pine-Featherville Road for 5.4 miles the property is located on the left.

Any and all interested persons shall be heard at said public hearing and the public is welcome and invited to submit testimony.
