<u>ADMINISTRATIVE</u>

Jeff and Goisalde Jausoro for a Conditional Use Permit to build a 1300 sq. ft. Dwelling Unit to be attached to an existing home on their property in Mountain Home, Idaho; the property is zoned Agriculture. Case Number: CUP-2019-04. The site is located at the Northeast ¼ of the Southeast ¼ of Section 13, Lot 1 Block 1, Bell Country Estates, B.M. A common way of locating the property is to head northeast on American Legion Blvd, turn left onto North 18th East for 2.2 miles, the property is located on the left.

<u>Jeff Jausoro</u> is the applicant. He stated that his in-laws are getting older and they are wanting them to be closer so they can help take care of them. He stated that they want to build a dwelling attached to their home and a variance is required due to the size of the dwelling.

Clark gave staff report and background.

Osborn stated that as she recalls the commission only makes a recommendation to the board for approval of a variance.

<u>Blount</u> stated that they have reviewed this process and found that no other city or county has that requirement for a variance. He stated that this was being misinterpreted all along as there is no reason for it. He stated that he has provided a legal opinion and footnotes in the staff report regarding this.

<u>Blount</u> stated that with the consent of the commission members they will change the application title to VAR-2019-01 as a CUP isn't the correct application for this process and was done in error.
