

COMMISSIONERS MINUTES

NOVEMBER 14, 2017

The Elmore County Commissioners met in special session on the above date in the Commissioners Room, basement of the Elmore County Courthouse, 150 South 4th East, Mountain Home, Idaho.

Present at the meeting were Chairman Al Hofer, Commissioners Bud Corbus and Wes Wootan, Civil Attorney Buzz Grant and Clerk Barbara Steele. Several members of the public were in the audience.

The purpose of this special session is to discuss the Western Elmore County Recreation District vacancies due to the results of the November 9, 2017 election.

After the recall election, the Western Elmore County Recreation District now has two vacancies. It is the Governor’s responsibility to select a replacement for one of the vacancies. The commissioners have been asked by the Governor to submit to his office names of interested individuals who would like to fill one of the vacancies. The commissioners feel that the public should be involved in the selection of the names that will be submitted to the Governor’s office and discussed the best way to accomplish this. It was decided that anyone interested would submit a resume and statement of interest and the commissioners would hold a public meeting. At the meeting, the commissioners will review the resumes of the interested applicants, allow the applicants to make a statement to the public and answer questions from the commissioners and the public. Once the meeting date, time and other specifics are finalized, Clerk Steele will publish a notice in the Mountain Home News to inform the public.
