NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho and Ordinances of Elmore County, that the Elmore County Planning and Zoning Commission will hold a PUBLIC HEARING at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 17, 2018, in the War Memorial Hall (American Legion) 515 East 2nd South Street, Mountain Home, Idaho, to accept testimony and consider an application from Albert Glen Janoushek for a Variance of setbacks on Applicant's property. Case Number: VAR-2018-01. The site is located at 415 West 12th South, Mountain Home, Idaho, Section 36, Township 3 South, Range 6 East. A common way of locating the property is to head West on American Legion Boulevard, turn left onto N. Main St./Old U.S. 30 E. for approximately 1/2 mile, continue onto W 6th S. St/Airbase Road, turn left onto S. 5th W. for approximately .5 miles then turn left onto W. 12th St. for 440 feet. The property is located on the right.

This application may be reviewed prior to the hearing in the Land Use and Building Department during regular business hours. Any and all interested persons shall be heard at said public hearing and the public is welcome and invited to submit testimony. Anyone who wishes to testify but is unable to attend may submit written testimony prior to the hearing by sending it to the Elmore County Land Use and Building Department, 520 East 2nd South Street, Mountain Home, Idaho, 83647. Due to limited time, written testimony will be accepted up until Monday October 15th to be included in the record.
