AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE RETAIL SALE OF WINE CONTAINING NOT MORE THAN
FOURTEEN (14) PER CENT ALCOHOL BY VOLUME WITHIN Elmore COUNTY
BY PERSONS OTHER THAN THE STATE LIQUOR DISPENSARY; ESTABLISHING
A LICENSE FEE FOR RETAIL LICENSES FOR RETAIL SALE OF WINE; PRO-
VIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Be It Ordained by the Board of County Commissioners of _____ County:

SECTION 1. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: WHEREAS, the Legislature
of the State of Idaho in the first regular session, 41st Legislature,
did, pursuant to Chapter 156, Session Laws of 1971, authorize the
retail sale of wine containing not more than 14% alcohol by persons
other than the State Liquor Dispensary, and authorizing the County
Commissioners of the various counties throughout the State to adopt
ordinances authorizing such sale, it is hereby declared to be the
purpose and intent of the County Commissioners of Elmore
County, State of Idaho, to authorize issuance of retail licenses
for the sale of wine within this county pursuant to the terms
and conditions of said Act.

SECTION 2. From and after the 1st day of July, 1971,
retail sales of wine containing not more than 14% alcohol by
volume shall be permitted and are hereby authorized in Elmore
County, State of Idaho.

SECTION 3. Before any person shall engage in the retail
sale of wine as defined in Chapter 156, Session Laws of 1971, as
enacted by the First Regular Session of the 41st Legislature of
the State of Idaho, such person shall apply to the County
Commissioners of Elmore County, State of Idaho, for a retail
wine license and shall pay an annual license fee therefor in the

sum of \$ 50 - . For the year 1971, the license fee shall be \$ 25 . No retail wine license shall be issued to an applicant who does not possess the qualifications set forth therefor in Chapter 156, Session Laws of 1971.

SECTION 4. The retail wine license of any retailer who violates any of the laws of the State of Idaho, or the United States, or of this county relating to the sale of alcoholic beverages, beer, or wine, shall be subject to revocation or suspension by the Board of County Commissioners of this county.

SECTION 5. This resolution and ordinance shall be effective from and after the 1st day of July, 1971.
