Shall the Board of Trustees be authorized to levy a supplemental levy in the amount of \$2.7 million per year for a period of two years commencing with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020, for the purpose of paying all lawful expenses of operating the schools of the district as provided in the resolution of the Board of Trustees adopted on February 18, 2020.

Shall the Board of Trustees of Bliss School District No. 234, Gooding, Twin Falls, Elmore Counties, Idaho be authorized and empowered to levy a School Plant Facilities Reserve Fund levy in the amount of \$50,000 - Fifty Thousand Dollars and no/100, for the first fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020 and continuing each year in the amount of \$50,000 Fifty Thousand Dollars and no/100 for 10 years for the purpose of allowing the District to acquire, purchase or improve school site or sites; to accumulate funds for and to build a school house or school house remodel or repair any existing building; to furnish and equip any building or buildings, including all lighting, heating, ventilation and sanitation facilities and appliances necessary to maintain and operate buildings of the District; to purchase school buses; for lease and lease purchase agreements for any of the above purposes and to repay loans from commercial lending institutions extended to pay for the construction of school plant facilities.

The following information is required by Section 34-439A, Idaho Code. The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$47 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions. The proposed levy will replace the District's existing plant levy which currently costs \$40 per \$100,000. The District's Plant Levy will increase by \$7 per \$100,000 per year.
