The Townsite site is in portions of Sections 12, 13, 14, 15, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26 & 27, Township 1N, Range 4E, and portions of Sections 7, 8, 17, 18, 19, 20 & 21, Township 1N, Range 5E, B.M.
