Maverik Reps- There has been a Traffic Study completed.

Chairperson Osborn- Notes her concerns with the location and the use of ITD snowplows and the already busy area with traffic.

Maverik Reps- We understand the concern and have completed all studies/ standards for an Impact Traffic Study as requested by ITD.

Commissioner Fish- Who can add a stop light to the area?

Maverik Reps- That would be ITD.
