Subject: Notice of Cease-and-Desist Order for Simco Road Regional Landfill

Dear Landfill Customer:

Please be advised that Elmore County Board of County Commissioners (Board) have been working with Idaho Regional Waste Systems, LLC (IRWS) over the last three years to operate the Simco Road Regional Landfill in compliance with local, state, and federal laws and regulations. After multiple attempts and two recent notices of violations, the Board has failed to achieve compliance from IRWS. Therefore, the Board has decided to revoke their Conditional Use Permit on November 3, 2023, which permitted them to operate this landfill in Elmore County. Furthermore, the Board has sent a Cease-and-Desist Order with Elmore County Sheriff to IRWS to stop operation of the landfill effective immediately. Which means that November 6, 2023 onwards, the Simco Road Regional Landfill should not be accepting any solid waste. All current customers are advised to find alternative waste disposal locations.

For all customers hauling waste generated in Elmore County, the Board offers an alternative facility where in-county trash will be accepted:

Bennett Road Transfer Station

Location: 6100 SE County Landfill Road, Mountain Home, ID 83647.

Hours of Operation: 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday; Closed on New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas.

Your understanding in this matter is appreciated. Elmore County's number one priority is to protect its citizens and ensure that vital public services such as solid waste disposal are done in a manner that is not harmful to our environment and the health and wellbeing of our citizens.
