QUESTION: Shall the Board of Trustees of School District No. 193, Elmore County, State of Idaho, be authorized and empowered to levy a Supplemental Levy in the amount of Two Million Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,700,000) per year for two (2) years, commencing with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2026, for the purposes stated above; all as provided in the Resolution adopted by the Board of Trustees on March 5, 2024?

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$48.22 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions. The proposed levy replaces an existing levy that expires on June 30, 2024, and that currently costs \$48.22 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value. Therefore, if the proposed levy is approved, the tax per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value is not expected to change.

Shall the Board of Trustees of Glenns Ferry Joint School District #192, Elmore & Owyhee Counties, Idaho, be authorized and empowered to levy a supplemental levy, as permitted by Idaho Code §33-802(3), in the amount of \$350,000 (Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars), per year for two (2) years commencing with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2026 for the purpose of financing any lawful expenses of maintaining and operating the schools of the District; all as provided in the Resolution of the Board of Trustees of Glenns Ferry Joint School District #192 adopted on March 13th, 2024.

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$71.00 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions. Currently, the District collects a supplemental levy that costs \$69.00 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, and the current levy will expire on June 30, 2024, so the proposed levy, if approved, produces a net increase of \$2.00 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value based on current conditions.
